PICTURE BOOKS ON STAGE

After every show, I meet with a group of local theatre-makers to talk about how that particular production came about, and to explore how it might influence their own creative work. We have nicknamed this group "The Sandbox" because there is a lot creative play at work in those sessions.

Lately, we have been diving into plays adapted from picture books. I imagine we will be having some musical fun post-Gruffalo, since Tall Stories has really embraced the musicality of Julia Donaldson's text by, well, making music with it.

One of the things we have rediscovered in the Sandbox is that there is no single path to making the world of a book come to life on stage. I hope you had the chance to see the Todd Parr stories in January, The Velveteen Rabbit in October, or Alice in Wonderland last season. Even our Fall 2021 stream of The Snail and the Whale, another play inspired by a Julia Donaldson book, took its own path to inviting us into the amazing worlds we have grown to love by turning page after page, time and time again.

Mouse's path will take us into the deep, dark wood in this one, but we expect it will be uneventful. After all, we all know there's no such thing as a Gruffalo, right?

AUTHOR JULIA DONALDSON • Julia Donaldson is the author of some of the world's best-loved children's books, including modern classics *The Gruffalo* and *The Gruffalo's Child*, which together have sold over 17 million copies worldwide, and the hugely successful *What the Ladybird Heard* adventures. Julia also writes fiction, including the *Princess Mirror-Belle* books illustrated by Lydia Monks, as well as poems, plays,

and songs – and her brilliant live shows are always in demand. She was Children's Laureate 2011-13 and has been honoured with a CBE for Services to Literature. Julia and her husband Malcolm divide their time between West Sussex and Edinburgh.



DIRECTOR OLIVIA JACOBS • Olivia trained at Central School of Speech and Drama and obtained a degree from the University of London before studying Japanese Children's Theatre in Tokyo. She worked with Besht Tellers, Black Theatre Co-operative, and Soho Theatre before becoming Artistic Director of Camden People's Theatre. Her directing credits include: *Wilde Creatures* (co-director, West End), *Emily Brown and the*

Thing (UK tour), The Gruffalo (UK, US including Broadway, Australia including Sydney Opera House, international), The Gruffalo's Child (UK, US, Asia and international), Snow White (UK/US tours including Broadway), Room on the Broom (UK, US, Australia including Sydney Opera House, international), The Extraordinary Adventures of Mr Benn (UK, international), How The Giraffe Got Its Neck (UK tour), William's Monsters (UK, international), Mum and the Monster (UK tour), Something Else (UK tour), The Happy Prince (UK tour), Rumpelstiltskin (UK tour), and Latke Who Couldn't Stop Screaming (UK tour). Olivia is co-founder and joint artistic director of Tall Stories.



COMPOSERS JOLLYGOODTUNES (JON FIBER AND ANDY SHAW) • Jon Fiber and Andy Shaw of Jollygoodtunes have been composing music and designing sound for theatre since 1997. Their work with Tall Stories includes Wilde Creatures, The Canterville Ghost, Mr Benn, William's Monsters, The Gruffalo's Child, Room on the Broom, Snow White, Something Else, The Owl and The Pussycat, and Rumpelstiltskin. Other

sound design work includes, *And All the Children Cried* (BAC, London), *Change of Heart, Modern Man, This Story of Yours* (New End Theatre), *Measure for Measure Malaya* (Riverside Studios). Beside their theatre work they also compose and record music for TV (BBC2, Discovery Channel, HSBC, Ericsson, and Johnnie Walker).



CREATIVE PRODUCER TOBY MITCHELL • Toby studied at Cambridge University and Central School of Speech and Drama. He has been a French and drama teacher, an editor at Macmillan Children's Books and designer of Total Theatre Magazine. Recent directing credits include *The Smeds* and *The Smoos* (UK Tour), *Wilde Creatures* (co-director, West End), *The Snail and the Whale* (UK, international), *Alfie White: Space*

Explorer (UK tour), My Brother the Robot (UK tour), Twinkle Twonkle (UK, US), The Snow Dragon (UK, international), *Does a Monster live Next Door*? (UK tour), *Cat and No Mouse* (Edinburgh/London), *The Owl and the Pussycat* (UK tour), *The Egg* (Edinburgh/London) and *Alice and Mr Dodgson* (Edinburgh/London). Recent performing/devising work includes: *Future Perfect, Monsters Got Talent, A British Guide to French Pop, The Island of First Loves* (Edinburgh), and *Pandemonium* (Edinburgh/London). He has worked with Soho Theatre and the Royal Court and is co-founder and joint artistic director of Tall Stories.



FOX, OWL, & SNAKE ANNA NICHOLSON • Anna is an award-winning writer and performer and has worked in the UK and internationally for over 10 years. Last year she wrote the script for pantomime *Cinderella* at the Oxford Playhouse and played Cindy-Lou in *The Grinch*. In 2021 she co-wrote and starred in series one of *The Adventures of the Juniper*, a children's sitcom set in space. In 2020 Anna was a sketch writer for

CBBC's *Crackerjack* and was short-listed for BBC's *Caroline Aherne Character Comedy Bursary*. Between 2018-2021 Anna wrote and performed two solo character comedy shows *Woman of the Year* and *Get Happy*. Her debut show was developed with Soho Theatre Young Company and BBC's *James Cary* (Miranda, Bluestone 42). These shows toured the UK, enjoyed sold out runs at the Edinburgh Fringe and were transferred to international festivals including New Zealand and Adelaide Fringe where she won a Best Comedy Award. Anna is excited to be working with Tall Stories again and can't wait to see you all at the shows.

Axel's artwork is exhibited internationally; he has illustrated for many charities, and designed the Royal Mail Christmas stamps in 2012. Born in Hamburg, Axel now lives with his family in London.




